Due:

Using the piece of poster board provided create a visual model of the format of a literary analysis. In your model, you must include and label the following elements (some will need to be used more than once):

- Thesis (and reasoning) in local terms
- Transition sentence
- Supporting paragraph
- Close reading
- Direct quotations
- Title and author of text
- Discussion of larger significance
- New perspective
- Topic Sentence
- Context for quotes
- Conclusion
- Thesis (and reasoning) in global terms

While your aim is to accurately depict a visual model of a literary analysis, you should also consider your audience: a more creative or interesting model may be more persuasive than a straightforward one.

You can use any materials you like, but you must confine yourself to the space provided!

Your model will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- how accurately you represent these elements
- how effectively you represent these elements
- how creatively you represent these elements
