AHSTF Terms and Conditions**THIS CONTRACT IS IMPORTANT**

PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND SIGN THE REGISTRATION FORM ON THE REVERSE

1. Responsibility Clause. Lakeland Tours, LLC d/b/a WorldStrides, its employees, shareholders, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, successors, agents, and assigns (collectively, "American High School Theatre Festival", or "AHSTF") school or other sponsor, and its and their employees (collectively, "Sponsor") does not own, operate or control any person or entity which is to or does provide goods or services for your trip including, for example, lodging facilities or dormitories, airline, vessel or other transportation companies, guides or guide services, local ground operators, entertainment or sightseeing operators, providers or organizers of optional excursions, food service providers, etc. All such persons and entities are independent contractors. As a result, neither AHSTF nor your Sponsor is liable for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any such person or entity, or of any third party.

Without limitation, neither AHSTF nor your Sponsor is responsible for any injury, loss, or damage to person or property, death, delay or inconvenience in connection with the provision of any goods or services whether occasioned by or resulting from, but not limited to, acts of force majeure, war, civil unrest, insurrection, strikes or other labor activities, criminal or terrorist activities of any kind, or the threat thereof, lost or stolen belongings, overbooking or downgrading of accommodations, mechanical or other failure of airplanes or other means of transportation or for any failure of any transportation mechanism to arrive or depart timely, dangers associated with animals, sanitation problems, food poisoning, epidemics or the threat thereof, lack of or quality of medical care, illness or disease, difficulty in evacuation in case of a medical or other emergency, actual, perceived or threatened epidemics, or for any other cause beyond the direct control of AHSTF or your Sponsor.

Changes in hotels or itinerary may be made at the discretion of AHSTF or your local ground operator as if or they deem necessary or desirable. AHSTF reserves the right to take photographic or film records of any of its trips and participant agrees that AHSTF may use any such photographic or film records for promotional and/or commercial purposes, and approves of such use by third parties whom AHSTF may engage without any remuneration to participant. Participant assigns to AHSTF all right, title, and interest in or to any and all media in which his or her name or likeness might be used.

AHSTF reserves the right to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of any trip. In the event a member is expelled from a trip, no refund of any kind will be made. AHSTF reserves the right to cancel any trip with its sole obligation to refund all monies received by it for the trip. Trip participants are solely responsible for securing their own passports, visas, medical inoculations, etc. These terms and conditions can be changed only by a writing signed by an officer of AHSTF.

I understand that I am solely responsible for my pre-program, program, and post-program medical care in all respects, including, but not limited to, obtaining and taking necessary medication(s), vaccinations and any other medical care and treatment. I certify that I will consult a physician qualified in travel medicine prior to my trip departure.

2. Arbitration. Any dispute concerning this contract, the Terms & Conditions and/or rules and regulations concerning the trip, the literature concerning the trip and/or the trip itself, shall be resolved solely and exclusively by binding arbitration in Charlottesville, Virginia pursuant to the then existing commercial rules of the American Arbitration Association. In any such arbitration, the substantive (but not procedural) law of the Commonwealth of Virginia shall apply. In any such arbitration, the arbitrator may, but is not required, to award attorney's fees to the prevailing party.

3. Program Arrangements. Except as otherwise agreed in writing, participant shall not make any independent arrangements for travel, hotel accommodations, tours, etc. Deviations from group travel must be requested in writing by March 15, 2007, and will be subject to a \$75 fee in addition to any fees imposed by the airline. A release form must be completed & signed for any and all deviations from the group travel. Each participant is responsible for his or her personal expenses of all sorts. Where requested by AHSTF, room assignments shall be made by Sponsor. No room changes shall be made without approval of Sponsor. Each participant is expected to participate in all scheduled activities.

4. Health and Safety Measures. AHSTF shall have the right, but not the duty, to take whatever action it deems necessary in regard to the health and safety of participant. Participant authorizes the adults on my trip and others with whom participant has contact, to obtain emergency treatment as deemed necessary by medical professionals. I grant to AHSTF the right to take whatever action it deems necessary in regard to my health and safety including, without limitation, obtaining medical treatment on my behalf and transporting me at my own or my parents' expense back to my home for medical reasons. Participant must submit to Sponsor a complete and accurate Medical Release form to be supplied by AHSTF. Any medical or physical conditions that may interfere with participation on the trip or with others on the trip must be stated.

5. Rules and Regulations. AHSTF and/or Sponsor will establish rules and regulations for all participants. Failure to abide by these rules or regulations may result in Participant being sent home at his, her or their parents' expense with no refund. Participants are responsible for exercising sound judgment, caution and respect for people, places and things while on the trip and must adhere to all rules and regulations. Consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages or non-prescription drugs of any kind, as well as violation of certain other rules, constitute grounds for immediate expulsion. **Participant must submit to Sponsor a signed Behavior Contract form to be supplied by AHSTF.**

6. Changes and Program Costs. The programs offered by AHSTF have been designed many months in advance of departure. AHSTF shall have the unqualified right to alter, amend, or cancel such programs and to make any adjustment to the program cost prior to departure in order to meet unanticipated contingencies, including any changes in transportation or lodging costs, airline increases, government issued taxes and fees, fuel surcharges, program costs, international exchange rates, or lack of participation in the program. It is understood that any requested additions or alterations to the program by Sponsor may increase the cost of the program.

7. Insurance. Personal Medical Insurance is not included. Accident, illness, and accident-related dental insurance coverage's are provided for all participants. Limits per single occurrence are \$5,000 for accident, \$1,500 for illness and \$750 for accident-related dental. Any charges not covered by this insurance are the responsibility of the participant. **This insurance is only payable for reimbursement upon return to the United States.** It cannot be used for payment of bills while in the United Kingdom. Pre-existing conditions and air travel are not covered under this accident policy. Worldstrides maintains a comprehensive liability policy. Participating enterprises all maintain insurance coverage. **Travel insurance is available for purchase by participants.**

8. Cancellation. In the event Sponsor or any participant desires to cancel a reservation without a replacement, it must be done in writing. Upon cancellation, AHSTF will retain program fees already paid by the participant as follows.

- Should a participant cancel (and no replacement be made) before September 12, 2008, AHSTF will retain \$50 of the initial \$150 deposit. **Satisfaction Guarantee Window - if a director decides, within two weeks of returning from the 2008 Familiarization trip, to withdraw his group from AHSTF 2009, AHSTF will refund the \$150 per participant deposit. Such cancellation must be submitted in writing.**
- Should a participant cancel between September 13, 2008 and October 30, 2008 AHSTF will retain \$250.
- Should a participant cancel between October 31, 2008 and January 29, 2009 AHSTF will retain \$500.
- Any cancellation occurring between January 30, 2009 and May 5, 2009 will result in retention of 25% of the total program fee for that participant.
- Cancellations made between May 6, 2009 and July 9, 2009 will result in 75% retention of the total program fee for that participant.
- For last minute cancellations on or after July 10, 2009 no refund will be made.

9. Late Registration Fee. Groups that have not completed their registration within 120 days or less from departure date will be subject to a \$10.00 per person late registration fee. Registration is considered completed when AHSTF receives the completed and signed '2009 AHSTF Registration Information' form.

10. Payment Schedule and Late Fees. AHSTF has set forth the following payment schedule:

- The non-refundable \$2750 deposit (due May 30, 2008) remains in your group's account, to be applied to your final balance at the time of your final payment (June 30, 2009).
- Your next payment is \$150 per participant deposit due July 13, 2008.
- On September 13, 2008 \$500 per participant is due
- On October 31, 2008 \$750 per participant is due
- On January 30, 2009 \$750 per participant is due
- On March 14, 2009 another \$1,000 per person installment payment is due.
- On May 5, 2009 another \$1,000 per person installment payment is due and your balance due will be invoiced in mid-June and due on June 30, 2009.

Any payment not made by an established due date is subject to a \$25.00 per person late fee.

11. Indemnification Participant and his/her parents/guardian agree to indemnify AHSTF and hold it harmless for any financial liability or obligation incurred or injury, damage, or loss to the person or property of others caused by student's participating in the Program.

12. Refunds. There will be no refunds, and/or substitutions for services, meals, sightseeing, accommodations and/or transportation (including air fare) missed or not used by participant regardless of the reason.

13. Free Time. There will be periods of free time on the trip. AHSTF is not responsible for participant or participant's activities while on free time.

14. Miscellaneous. I certify that I do not have any physical or mental condition which will create a danger or hazard for me, other participants or chaperones in the program.
